

Welcome to the Deer Park Women's Golf Club! 2019

-

- * Club membership fees are \$61/year, which includes GHIN activation and Club handbook
- * Although our play day is normally on Wednesday the Club has three Thursday play dates. New this year are two Shotgun starts and three back nine starts. Check your handbook for dates and times. You can play either nine or eighteen holes.
- * Sign-up sheets for morning tee times-both 9 and 18 holes-are at the clubhouse desk. Signup for tee times is generally done the week before. You can also call the Pro Shop at 509-276-5912 to make afternoon and evening tee times.
- * You must sign up and pay before play to participate in the weekly gross/net payout, weekly games and gross/net skins. These are all optional. All games and activities are explained further in this handbook.
- * You are welcome to bring a guest. You must play with a Women's Club member, however, for your round to count towards any of the games/payouts for that week.
- * Scrambles will be held monthly, May-August. See calendar for dates. The cost for the scramble is \$3/person. The rules will be handed out on the night of the scramble. There will be a social hour to follow at the clubhouse.
- * Meetings-check the calendar for dates and times.

When you check in on league day:

Sign up & pay for the games you want to play

You must be signed up to be eligible for the payouts.

The winnings from all the games are paid as credit at the pro shop

Weekly results are posted on the bulletin board by the Ladies restroom & online.

- ◆ **Birdy's** -are paid \$2 per occurrence or you can receive a Birdy pin
- ◆ **Chipin's**- are paid \$2 per occurrence
- ◆ **Eagle**- receive an Eagle ball marker (new for 2019)

There are sign-up sheets for these on the bulletin board.

GHIN

Posting begins March 1st and ends November 14 every year.

It is ok to use the GHIN mobile app to post your scores unless you have an equitable stroke change, then post your score at the Clubhouse.

How to calculate your net score

Step 1: start with your course handicap (not course index)

Step 2: In a corner of the score box underneath each hole, put a little dot for each stroke of handicap you have, starting with the toughest hole (marked "1"). Continue until you get to 18.

Step 3: If you still have strokes left on your handicap, start over by "1" and add a second dot. Repeat this process until you have used up your entire handicap.

The number of dots in every box represents the number of strokes you can deduct from your gross score to get your net score on each particular hole

Example:

Course handicap is 34 $34-18=16$

Two strokes on 16 holes: 1-2-3-4-6-7-9-10-11-12-13-14-17-18

One stroke on 2 holes: 8 & 16

Course handicap is 21 $21-18=3$

Two strokes on 3 holes: 6-9-14

One stroke on 15 holes: 1-2-3-4-5-7-8-10-11-12-13-15

Pace of Play Tips

4 hours 15 minutes per 18 holes

1. Play ready golf – forget "honors" and forget "away".
2. Plan your shots while others are hitting – on and off the green. Have next club ready.
3. If riding, drop off first player, drive to second ball. Second player should be ready when first player has hit.
4. Always carry tees, ball markers, and an extra ball in your pocket.
5. First player to putt in, tends the flag for the other golfers until the last golfer putts out.
6. Putt continuously until you hole out, unless restricted by another golfers line
7. Limit your search for lost balls., 3 min maximum. (New rules change)
8. Be efficient with pre-shot routine, usually one practice swing.
9. Leave your clubs, or cart, in a path to the next tee, never in front of the green.
10. Mark scorecards on the next tee box, not next to the putting green.
11. **Always keep up with the group ahead of you.** If you are falling behind, speed up or allow the group behind to "play through".

Special KP April 3-September-25

- A weekly contest of closest to the pin.
- \$2/play-\$1 to weekly winner and \$1 to shootout pot
- Each weekly winner wins a shot in the final shootout. A player may win more than one shot.
- Final shootout payouts to 1/3 of the field (one person may win more than one place)
- **Shootout will be Thursday September, 26 @ 5:30pm**

Weekly KP April-September

In addition to the Special KP contest there will be a Weekly KP

\$1- for 9 holes and \$2-for 18 holes

9 hole league-opposite of the Special KP-Par 3 Hole

18 hole league on #13 & #16 & on back nine starts-#4 & #8

18 hole league-on alternating front 9 par 3's and both back nine par 3's on the back

9 hole evening Ladies who participate in the scrambles will be eligible for the Special & Weekly KP's during the scrambles

Hole in One Insurance \$1 per person

Hole in One pot is paid to anyone who gets hole in one on league day while playing with a leaguemember during a Deer Park women's club event.

This includes scrambles, club championship, and match play.

In the event more than one person scores on the same day the pot will be split equally

FAIRWAY DOTS

One dot for each player whose drive lands ON THE FAIRWAY.
Second dot for each player whose second shot ALSO lands on the fairway.
One dot on par 3 holes for landing ON THE GREEN with the first shot

TOMBSTONE

Each player is given a small Tombstone (or flag) with her name on it.
Play until she has used the number of strokes equaling par plus her *course* handicap (not handicap index).
Plant your Tombstone where the ball lands on your last allowed stroke—this is where you DIED!

Mark this hole on your card.

Play past 9/18 if needed. The player who has “lived” the longest wins!

ONES

Total of your holes beginning with these letters

O-N-E-S (1, 6, 7,8,9,11,16,17,18)

Put these score on the “game” line

Net Skins -Place your “net” score on the game line. Dot your cards ladies!

Pro’s Choice (5/10 holes)

The Pro will pick the holes that count towards the game. Find out which holes at the end of the round

Add your score from the selected holes to get your “game” score.

Hate –

BEFORE play, circle the three (for nine) or six (for 18) holes you hate on your card.

Record and post your score on these holes as played. For the game, you get a par on those 3/6 holes.

Putting around

Hole in on	Automatic win
Chipin	6 points
Sandi par	5 points, get a par after being in a waste bunker
Birdy	4 points

One putt	3 points
Two putts	1 point
Three putts	Minus 3 points

3 blindholes will be randomly selected **after play**. Subtract these holes from your gross score. New low score wins.

Stabeleford-Modified

This is all done by the computer! YEAH!

PIN HIGH

You get one point if you are the first ball on the green and within the length of the flagstick from the cup **or** one point if your ball is first on the green. Possible 9 or 18 points

Blind Draw Best Ball

The computer will do the draws. YEAH!

3's and 5's

Your total score for the game is the net total of all the par threes and par fives

T & F

Only your scores on the holes beginning with T & F (2-3-4-5 10-12-13-14-15)count.

Write your Gross and Net T & F score on the card. (Dot your card for the net score).

BEAT THE PRO

All members beating the pro's gross score with their net score will split the prize money

Quit Yore Bitchin

Play golf as usual

Throw out the worst holes and take a par on each

Circle the 2 worst holes for the 9 holers

Circle the 4 worst holes for the 18 holers
