Tuesday Two-Man Series — 2026

Monthly Team Competition • Men's Club Tuesday Play

Beginning in May, the Men's Club will introduce a monthly Tuesday Two-Man Series during select Tuesday play. These events replace the traditional Tuesday stroke-play round once per month and introduce a variety of two-man team formats along with a season-long points competition.

Season standings are based on each player's three highest point finishes.

WHY WE CREATED THIS SERIES

- 1 Add more variety to Tuesday play
- 2 Encourage greater participation on Tuesday nights
- 3 Allow members to play with different partners
- 4 Introduce fun team formats during the season
- 5 Create a season-long competition

HOW THE SERIES WORKS

- 1 Show up Tuesday
- 2 Choose a partner
- 3 Play the format of the month
- 4 Each player earns individual series points based on where their team finishes
- 5 Best 3 finishes count toward the season standings

POINTS SYSTEM

Finish	Points
1st	12
2nd	10
3rd	8
4th	7
5th	6
6th	5
7th	4
8th	3
9th	2
10th	1

KEY RULES

- 1 Players may choose a different partner for each event
- 2 Maximum 7-stroke handicap difference between partners
- 3 Scores must be attested by another group
- 4 Ties for each event will be broken using the USGA scorecard playoff method (9-6-3-1)

SEASON CHAMPIONS (Best 3 Finishes Count)

Single Gross and Net champions will be determined by the total series points from each player's best three finishes. If players are tied at the conclusion of the series, ties will be broken using the following order:

- 1 Highest individual finish during the series
- 2 Second-highest finish
- 3 Third-highest finish
- 4 Putt-off

Only finishes that count toward a player's best three scores will be used when applying tie-breakers.
